

# **Teaching Station Jr**

University of Toronto Standard Electronic Podium Like Teaching Station, with fewer capabilities - no standard onboard computer (typically user provides laptop and logs-on via laptop)

## Use

Standard equipment for classrooms capacity 36 - 100 Controls data projector and room audio Laptop connection point (onboard computer not included in base configuration) Internet connection and UofT UTORid log-in (network) Fixed location for laptop/notes Designed for instructor to stand either at front or at side of unit

#### Equipment


Laptop connection cable (VGA Video-out and mini-jack Audio-out to projector) Audio volume control (room amplifier inside unit or external) Audio/Video source selector (Crestron) Power outlets (2) Standard AV jack input for Video (yellow) and Audio (white/red) Intercom to AV helpline (VoIP) \* Unit can be custom expanded to include computer, dvd etc

#### Size (approximate)

2' x 2' footprint Unit height 36" Front retractable shelf 30" from floor


# **Conduit Feed**


Unit is located against wall so floor trenching not required for cable feeds. Data (for VoIP and network log-in), power, conduit feed to projector, screen control, speakers. See UofT standard 'Wall AV access panel' for preferred conduit connection point.



# Position


Located against wall - steel frame bolted to either wall or floor Side wall mount prefer - Minimum 4' from presentation wall (if available) Presentation wall mount if side wall too far/not available. Located to one side of screen so professor does not block view of screen Located on side away from entrance/exit
