FLIP-TOP FOR NESTING (SHOWN WITH ASYMMETRICAL Y-LEG; OSM PREFERS THE SIMPLER SYMMETRICAL Y-LEG)
NEWER VERSION AVAILABLE WITH SINGLE BAR FOR ACTIVATING THE FLIP,
RATHER THAN 2 LEVERS

Applications:

- Loose table for any classrooms (student table or professor table)
- Allow min 24" width/student, ideal is 30"+ per student (width)
- Standard classroom depth is 18 24"
- OSM usually orders (for 2 students/table): 2x4' table if tight spacing is required, prefer 20x60, 24x60 or 30x60 if space allows. 30x60 also functions as a small group-work table order with legs inset 10" from the sides to allow seating on all sides
- Legs mounted independently on underside of table allowing them to be placed 10" from ends, to allow end-table seating
- 'Y' leg allows feet to go underneath when sitting at end (preferred to 'T-leg')
- Superb welding and construction on the legs durable and attractive

The Trek table is the newer OSM standard classroom table because of its excellent construction, practical 'Y-leg' design and variety of options.
